

Students' Call for Proposals 2009 for EPFL Students – ROUND 1 (“Competition”)

This Competition is initiated and organized by Nokia Corporation, represented by its business unit, Nokia Research Center in Lausanne, for EPFL (Ecole Polytechnique Federale de Lausanne) students (in collaboration with the university). This is a chance to submit any idea related to mobile applications or services with a special emphasis on social interactions.

This Competition offers EPFL students an opportunity to win the latest Nokia devices (N810, E71, N96).

To enter, form a team of between one and three persons to innovate an appealing application or service that is based on a mobile device, and submit it with the required documentation. Each team selects a team name and nominates a Team Leader who represents the team in all communications with the organizers (persons forming single-person teams are automatically defined as Team Leader).

The idea must be feasible to implement on Nokia N810 Internet tablets and the primary criteria for success include novelty, innovativeness, benefit for end user, feasibility (at least demo level implementation realizable within one year) and potential to make impact.

Volunteers may also be invited to implement their contributed ideas during a second round of the call using Nokia N810 Internet tablets (but there will be a separate description and participation commitment form related to the second round).

Requirements

- Application/service idea must be feasible to implement on a Nokia N810 internet tablet device.

Entry components (delivered by using the provided template):

- Basic description of the application/service idea
- What are the problems known in current products/services/solutions, which are solved with this proposal?
- How does the proposal differ from known products/services/solutions?
- Value (benefit) for consumers (and/or industry)

Primary Success Criteria:

- Novelty
- Creativity: originality, degree of technology innovation and innovativeness
- Benefit for end user
- Feasibility
- Potential to make market/business impact

Student credits

Participants with good ideas may have the opportunity to convert them to semester projects for spring or fall 2009. Each team/student must agree these terms with their contact professor/teacher.

The Prizes

Each of the members of the teams submitting the overall best ideas selected from all participating teams will be awarded one of the latest Nokia devices (N810, E71 or N96). Nokia aims to select at least three winning teams. Winners may not demand that the prizes be changed for cash or for value. Nokia reserves the right to substitute a suitable prize of similar value in the event any prize originally specified is not available for whatever reason.

Terms & Conditions

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the "*Students' Call for Proposals 2009 for EPFL Students – ROUND 1*" ("the Competition") which will be held from 16th February 2009 to 1st March 2009. ("Period of Competition").
2. The main organizer of this Competition is Nokia Corporation, represented by its business unit, the Nokia Research Center – Lausanne ("Nokia" or the "Organizer"), located at the EPFL campus (Scientific Park).
3. Before submitting an entry, each participant must first read and accept these terms and conditions of the Competition, and agree to accept the final decision of the jury.
4. This Competition is open to students from EPFL. Each participant represents that he or she is at least 18 years of age. At the Organizer's request participants shall provide proof of enrollment at EPFL.
5. Information related to the Competition is available at <http://research.nokia.com>.
6. Teams of between one and three students can participate in the Competition. Each team can submit only one entry to the Competition. No purchase or admission fee is necessary to participate.
7. The Competition closes to new entries on March 1st 2009 and eligible submissions must be received no later than 11:59pm (CET). No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, ineligible or misdirected submissions.
8. To enter the Competition participants need to provide a full name, email address, and country of residence. The personal data that a participant submits via the entry form will be assembled into a database that is used for evaluating the applications and managing the Competition, as well as for purposes of contacting participants in case of need. This data will not be used for any purposes other than for the purposes of this Competition and as otherwise stated below. However, we reserve the right to display participant names when showing content submitted to the Competition, unless a participant separately tells Nokia otherwise.
9. The winners will be determined by a jury appointed by Nokia in its sole discretion and such decision shall be final. Nokia shall be under no obligation to review further correspondence. Each of the members of the teams that submit the overall best ideas selected from all participating teams will be awarded one of the latest Nokia devices (N810, E71 or N96). Nokia aims to select at least three winning teams. Winners may not require that the prizes be changed for cash or for value. Nokia reserves the right to substitute a suitable prize of similar value in the event any prize originally specified is not available for whatever reason. Nokia reserves the rights not to award any entry at all in case of low quality or if it considers, in its sole discretion, the entries to be incomplete, inaccurate, corrupted or otherwise unsuitable.
10. The winner(s) will be contacted directly by email or telephone within fourteen (14) days of being identified. If despite reasonable efforts Nokia is unable to contact a relevant winner within that period, Nokia reserves the right to choose a substitute winner.
11. Prizes will be issued to the winner(s) within forty five (45) days of contact being made by Nokia in accordance with section 10, subject to the requirement that all relevant information necessary for Nokia to issue the prize has been provided. Nokia shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) in the delivery of the prizes to the winners.
12. The prize offered will be accepted in the knowledge that the winner may become liable to local tax contributions and any prize awarded may have to be declared on an annual tax return as required. Any tax liability will be the responsibility of the winner. All costs associated with the prizes, including but not limited to operator subscription fees, shall be paid by the winning participants. All prizes are subject to the same warranties and service conditions as products sold at retail. Nokia accepts no other liability whatsoever that may be caused by any prize awarded to any person in this Competition.

13. Each participant represents and warrants that that his or her entry is the participant's own original work and has not been previously published. Each participant also represents and warrants that his or her entry does not misrepresent an association or connection to some person, brand or thing that it does not actually have, and is not defamatory, libelous, vulgar, obscene, derogatory, pornographic, objectionable with respect to race, religion, creed, national origin, gender or sexual preference, or is otherwise inappropriate or unfit for publication. The participant agrees to use reasonable efforts to scan and remove any viruses before submitting any material for the Competition.
14. Participants agree to keep their entry confidential and not to disclose their entry to any third party other than Nokia, until the announcement of the winning entries on March 13th, 2009. In addition, participants submitting winning entries agree to keep their entries confidential until April 15, 2009. Nokia may disclose submitted entries to third parties or publicly at any time. It may not be possible for the participant to file for patent protection after any publication of the information by Nokia.
15. Nokia may at any time offer to a participant to file patent applications in any jurisdiction for any entry in Nokia's name and at Nokia's expense in exchange for a cash invention reward. If Nokia makes such an offer, the participant may accept this offer at his or her discretion.
16. Participants submitting winning entries hereby grant to Nokia a worldwide, fully paid, non-exclusive, sublicensable, transferable, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable commercial license, under all intellectual property rights, to make, use, sell, import and export the winning entries, incorporate the winning entries into products and services, and copy, distribute, duplicate, display, perform, and make derivative works from the winning entries. For the avoidance of doubt, Nokia does not claim through this document any ownership of entries. Nokia may invite winning participants to work together with Nokia on developing an implementation of the winning entry, subject to the terms of a separate agreement.
17. Each participant represents and warrants that it is not employed by any third party, including EPFL, that he or she has not assigned or licensed its interest in all or any part of its entry to any third party, and has all rights needed to grant the licenses and use rights provided in these Terms and Conditions. For clarity, if you have an employment or other agreement with EPFL or any other party in which you have assigned any rights in an entry, then you should not participate in the Competition.
18. Submissions that are offensive or improper in nature, or are deemed harmful will be subject to disqualification.
19. By submitting information for the Competition, each participant hereby agrees and consents to Nokia retaining and using without charge all or any part of the data/information submitted by participant for its sales, marketing and promotional efforts and to the furnishing of such data/information to Nokia related entities and their agents for such purposes, in each case until 31st December 2011. Each participant is required to provide all reasonably requested information accurately. If a participant does not provide the information, such participant cannot participate in the Competition. Nokia may also use participant's information to contact the participant in the future for marketing and promotional purposes. Each participant's personal information may be disclosed to relevant authorities and winners' names may be published as required under the relevant legislation or otherwise. 20. The Organizer accepts no liability for lost, damaged, misdirected or delayed entries or any technical difficulties affecting the end result of the Competition or the entry to the Competition. By participating the participant, and the winners, by acceptance of their prizes, agree to release and hold harmless Organizer, its affiliates, subsidiaries, and their officers, employees, agents and representatives from any and all liability, claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses, which may be sustained directly or indirectly in connection with participation in this Competition or with the receipt, ownership or use of the prize or while preparing for, participating in, and/or traveling to any prize-related activity. The organizer expressly disclaims any responsibility or liability for injury or loss to any person or property relating to the delivery and/or subsequent use of the prize awarded.
21. This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Finland, excluding its rules for choice of law. Any disputes relating to or arising in connection with this Agreement shall be finally settled in arbitration. The arbitrator is to be appointed by the Arbitration Committee of the Central Chamber of Commerce of Finland and the rules of the said Committee are to be followed in the arbitration. The award shall be final and binding and enforceable in any court of competent jurisdiction. The arbitration shall be held

in Helsinki, Finland, in English language. The parties undertake and agree that all arbitral proceedings conducted with reference to this Article shall be kept strictly confidential and all information disclosed in the course of such arbitral proceeding shall be used solely for the purpose of those proceedings. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to limit the parties' rights to seek interim injunctive relief or to enforce an arbitration award in any court of law.
